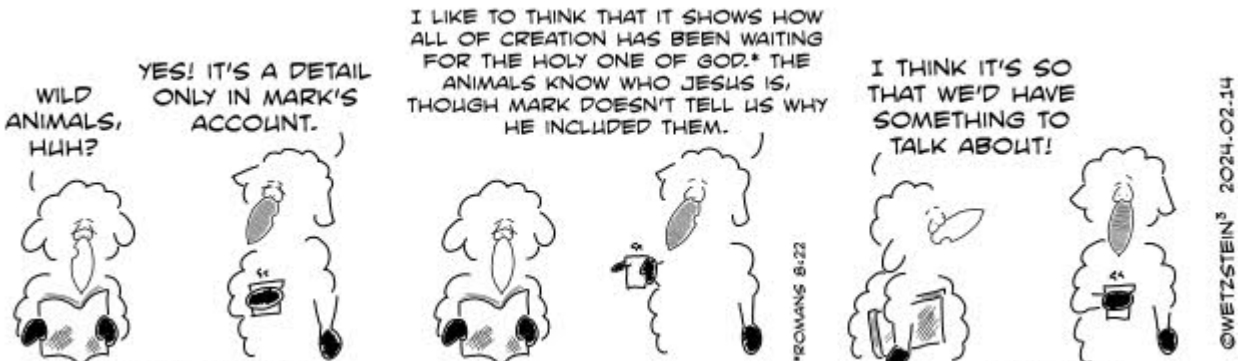
## Announcements
